

CFA League Penalty for Player and Coach Ejections

Player Ejection

The first time a player is ejected he has to sit out the remainder of the half he was ejected and the next half.

Example: If a player is ejected in the first or second quarter of a game, he would sit out the remainder of the first half and second half of that game. If he is ejected in the third or fourth quarter of a game he would sit out the remainder of that game and the first half of the next scheduled game.

The second time a player is ejected he would sit out the remainder of the game and all of the next scheduled game.

A third ejection would disqualify the player for the remainder of the season. If the player is not a senior he may only be reinstated for the next season upon appeal.

NOTE: Player ejections must be reported to the league office by the coach on Monday following the game.

Coach Ejection

Regular season: Anytime a coach is ejected he will sit out the remainder of the game and the next scheduled game. A second ejection will lead to an indefinite suspension but an appeal will be heard.

Semi-final game: The ejected coach will sit out the rest of the game if ejected in the first half. If ejected in the second half he will sit out the remainder of that game and the first quarter of the championship game if his team wins.

Championship game: The ejected coach will sit out the remainder of the game and the next game the following year.
