We are looking forward to you being with us in Hueytown, AL for the ACAA Baseball and Softball Tournament. Here is some information that will be helpful for the upcoming event.

- All games (baseball and softball) will be played at Bud Newell Park, 2501 Brooklane Drive, Hueytown, Alabama 35023.
- No one will be admitted on the fields until 11:00 a.m. on Friday and 8:00 a.m. on Saturday.
- Please make sure all players and fans remain in the athletic field area.
- Concessions and restrooms will be available.
- Coaches, please make sure you fill out the all-tournament ballots and return them to Jack Scott or his designee before the start of the championship games.
- Tournament team coaches, bookkeepers, and managers will be admitted free of charge. Please help by ensuring all spectators pay admission.
- Tournament players wearing uniforms will be admitted.
- Players or parents wanting to keep home run balls may pay \$6.00 for softball/ \$5.00 for baseball.
- Your players will need to arrive dressed and ready to play dressing rooms will not be available.
- A hospitality area will be available for coaches, spouses, school administrators, and media. It will be housed in a designated area for this purpose.
- Bleachers are available; however, fans are welcome to bring personal chairs. There will be space available for tents for each team, please bring your own canopy.
- Parking may be limited. We will have an area for buses. Please follow directions on the day of the tournament.

NOTE: Please cooperate with the tournament host and others to ensure a smooth, well-run tournament.

No one will be admitted on the fields until 11:00 a.m. on Friday and 8:00 a.m. on Saturday.

Baseball

- Baseball teams need to bring 5 new baseballs per game, the size according to the NFHS Rules Book.
- Baseball teams may take the infield, 25 minutes before game time for the visiting team, and 15 minutes before game time for the home team.
- The home team dugout will be on the third base side of the field, the visiting team on the first base side.
- A coin toss will determine the home team.
- Teams, please exit the dugout as soon as your game is over to prevent delay of the tournament. Hold post-game meetings outside the dugouts.
- Please do not enter the field until the previous team has exited the dugout.
- The home team book will be the official book.

Softball

- All teams will need to supply **2 new softballs per game**, the size according to the NFHS Rules Book. Bring balls to the plate meeting.
- Teams will be allowed 10 minutes infield warm-ups prior to the first game of the day only.
- Tournament games are seven innings with a ten-run mercy rule after five innings and fifteen after four innings. The international tiebreaker rule will only go into effect in the 10th inning to avoid extremely long games.
- Tournament games will have one minute between innings. Umpires will move games along.
- The home team dugout will be on the first base side of the field, the visiting team on the third base side.
- A coin toss will determine the home team.
- Teams, please exit the dugout as soon as your game is over to prevent delay of the tournament.
 Hold post-game meetings outside the dugouts.
- Please do not enter the field until the previous team has exited the dugout.
- The home team book will be the official book.

Game Times

It is suggested that weeknight games start between 6 PM and 7 PM; Saturday games between 11 AM and 2 PM. Host school should contact the visiting school to work out a mutually acceptable time. If game time must vary from above times, please contact the ACEA office at (205) 631-3000 or e-mail at acea2000@bellsouth.net.

Officials

It is the responsibility of the host school to contact their local booking agent for officials. Host school should request "tournament quality" officials, preferably officials not assigned to host school during the current season.

Concessions

Host school may provide a concession area. Profits from the concessions will be the property of the host school.

Gate

Host school should provide personnel to work the gate for the sub-state game. Gate prices are set by the ACEA office and are uniform throughout the sub-state rounds. An *ADMISSION COST to ATHLETIC EVENTS list is posted on the ACAA website at www.alabamachristianathletics.com*. All monies should be submitted to the ACEA office, using the "Game Finance Summary" provided by the league office. Everyone entering the game should be charged the posted rate. *YELLOW Coaches Cards are the only cards accepted during post season play.*

Scorer / Timer

The host school should provide a qualified scorer to keep the official book for the game. Host school should also provide an ACAA approved clock operator for the game.


